Memorial Service for Clint Joseph "CJ" Hubbard to be held at the San Francisco Solano Catholic Church in Rancho Santa Margarita

Rancho Santa Margarita, CA, December 11th 2009: The community of Orange County will be mourning the loss of a beloved man that inspired so many to live life to the fullest. CJ Hubbard will be remembered by what is expected to be over 500 people that considered him a brother, a friend, a mentor, and a ray of sunshine. The Memorial service will take place at 1:00PM at San Francisco Catholic Church in Rancho Santa Margarita, followed by a commemorative reception of CJ's life.

CJ's story shocked not only the community of Orange County, but also affected so many due to the fact that his death could have happened to anyone. Hubbard, 27, was taken off life support on Friday November 27, after being assaulted outside a nightclub early Thanksgiving morning.

To bring awareness to CJ's story, Hubbard's family has created The CJ Hubbard Foundation. The foundation is in the process of applying for status as a 501(c) (3) tax-exempt organization. The foundation is

dedicated to providing financial assistance for students in the Southern California area, making it possible for them to attend Santa Margarita Catholic High School and The University of California, Los Angeles; the two institutions that Hubbard credited with much of his success in life.

Hubbard was born on August 5, 1982. He graduated from Santa Margarita Catholic High School in 2001. Hubbard was a standout athlete at SMCHS and went on to graduate from UCLA in 2005. After college, Hubbard moved to Newport Beach, where he began work in commercial real estate as a tenant representative for Cresa Partners. Hubbard loved basketball, golf, and UCLA sports. CJ was always passionate about giving back to the campuses that forever left a footprint on his life and his on theirs.
